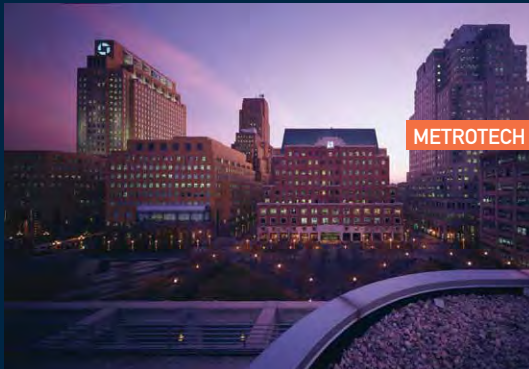




BROOKLYN HEIGHTS

With **BROOKLYN HEIGHTS'** 19th-century brownstones, Federal-style frame buildings, architecturally significant churches, and tree-lined streets, it's no surprise the neighborhood was named the first New York City Historic District in 1965. **MONTAGUE STREET**, a shopping area of upscale boutiques and sidewalk cafes, leads to the **1 Brooklyn Heights Promenade**, famous for its view of New York Harbor, the Statue of Liberty, the Manhattan skyline, and the Brooklyn Bridge. The **2 Brooklyn Historical Society** holds exhibits and tours, while the **3 Toy Museum of NY** displays playthings from the 1880s on.



METROTECH

Built around The Commons, a 3½ acre tree-filled park, the 10-block **METROTECH** area is one of America's most successful urban redevelopment projects. In addition to major private enterprises, the complex includes the **7 Bridge Street Church**, NYC College of Technology, the NYC Fire Department, Long Island University, and the **8 TKTS Discount Ticket Booth**. Three landmarks — the **9 BellTel Lofts**, **10 Duffield Street Houses**, and former **11 Brooklyn Fire Headquarters** — delight architecture fans, while an array of restaurants offer an international selection of foods.

**BROOKLYN CIVIC CENTER's** Borough Hall, a Greek-revival landmark, served as Brooklyn's City Hall until 1898 and is now the Borough President's office; the **4 Brooklyn Visitors Center** is on the ground floor. Summer concerts, a year-round greenmarket, and other events take place in the adjacent **5 Borough Hall Plaza**. Just north and lined with historic and judicial buildings, Cadman Plaza Park — home to the WWII Memorial and other monuments — provides a green route to the **6 Brooklyn Bridge pedestrian path**. South of Borough Hall are the Court Street and Livingston Street shopping districts and the **6 NY Transit Museum**, which displays historic subway cars and other artifacts.

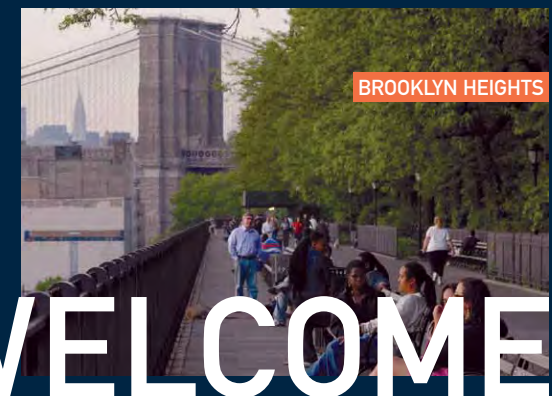


BROOKLYN CIVIC CENTER

Urban department store shopping originated on **FULTON STREET**, which can be seen at the landmarked **12 Namm's Department Store** and the **13 Offerman Building**. **FULTON STREET'S** eclectic mix of national chains and local enterprises defines today's urban style. Visitors will find restaurants like the world-famous Junior's and 150 stores selling a wide variety of clothing, footwear, sporting goods, electronics, and jewelry. After shopping, you can enjoy the new **14 Albee Square Plaza**, which is located adjacent to the landmarked **15 Dime Savings Bank Building**.

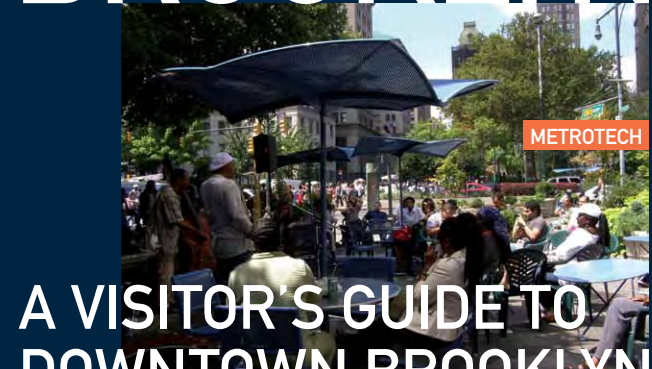

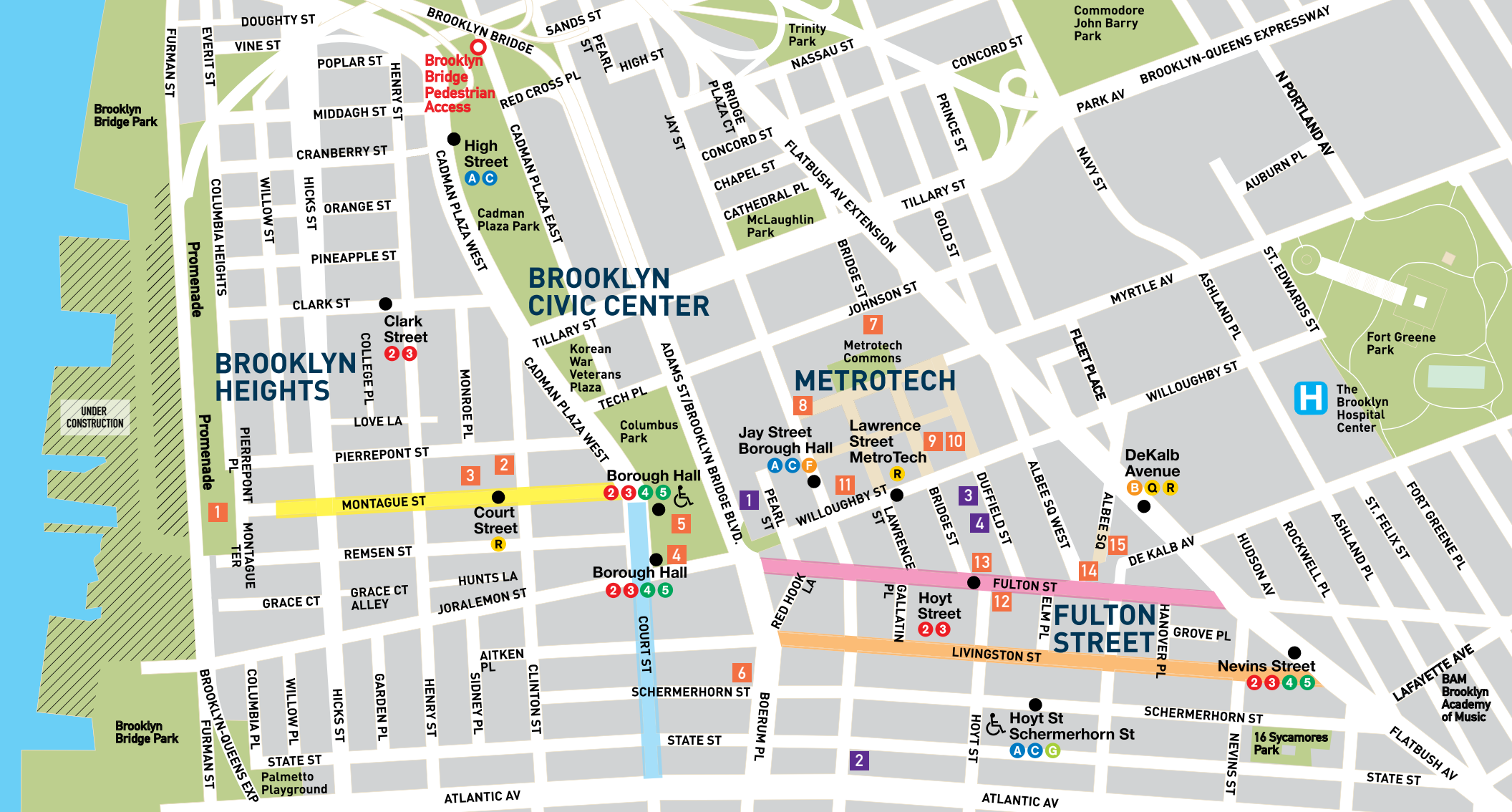
